Votes are IN.....

The votes have been counted and the results of the proposed Havana Standard Changes are as followed...

1. Change of Judging order —Fail with a 7 Accept 77 Reject
2. Removal of 2 pts from Eye and add to Fur --Fail 31 Accept to 51 Reject
3. Removal of 3 pts from Feet & Legs to Fur—Fail 22 Accept to 62 Reject
4. Drop Max weight to 6 1/4lbs Fail 8 Accept to 75 Reject
5. Replace flat spot with long or low shoulders—Passed 53 Accept to 31 Reject
6. Describes furring on ears—Fail 34 Accept to 51 Reject
7. Removes medium length from the Standard—Fail 37 Accept to 49 Reject
8. Adds measurable length of guard hair—Fail 26 Accept to 58 Reject
9. Adds description of undercoat density—Passed 44 Accept to 41 Reject
10. Adds fault for excessively coarse fur—Fail 38 Accept to 48 Reject
11. Adds fault for thin coats—Fail 34 Accept to 51 Reject
12. Adds faults for cotton coats—Fail 37 Accept to 49 Reject.
13. Adds faults for excessively long or short coats—Fail 31 Accept to 54 Reject.

Some of these were very close. So these two changes will be presented to the ARBA Standards Committee they will have to vote to approve them. If they accept these changes they will be in the next ARBA Standard.

Want to THANK Uno Kivi and his hard work on these proposals along with the rest of the Standard Committee. It is these folks dedication to the breed that makes raising Havana so great. Thanks

Greetings one last time Havana Breeders,

This is my last article as your Standards Committee Chairman. When I took this position I said that I would serve for one five year term. That period will draw to a close and President Meyer will be charged with forming a new committee to keep guide our breed in the future. If you are interested in serving on the committee now would be an excellent time to let him know that you are interested in the position.

We did have two standards changes that were accepted by the club and will be forwarded to the ARBA Standards Committee. These should be included in this newsletter. First, we added a description to

the undercoat. This should help aide our judges in producing a more consistent decision on the quality of our animal's coat. Then we updated the wording on the shoulder faults. This was a minor change that adds a better physical description to the fault. Both of these changes will be forwarded to the ARBA Standards Committee for review. They will send it to the ARBA board of Directors.

I was surprised that many of the other fur changes were not approved by the membership. Finding acceptable fur faults may be an area that the next standards committee will want to examine, as it seems odd that a breed with such an emphasis on fur continues to fail to list faults.

With leaving this position my focus will shift to improving my own herd. It may not always appear so, but this position requires a lot of time and focus. One of the casualties of this has been my ability to work with my own animals.

In addition, I will be able to shift my rabbit focus to continuing to make the WCC one of the premier shows in the country. I would like to invite the membership to join us if you get a chance. The WHO always puts on a great specialty show with excellent competition and judges.
