## He will be missed. Rabbit world lost a great breeder



We are here to enjoy the hobby that we love with fellow exhibitors, many who have become our friends and indeed our family. Today we also remember a member of that family who has very recently passed.

The rabbit world lost a true friend and a tremendous rabbit breeder. Larry Wagner JR passed away on Thursday, January 23 due to a massive heart attack. Larry was born on April 18, 1971. At only 42 years of age, Larry had a lot planned for his rabbit future. For years, Larry had arguably the best Harlequins in the country and served as President for the national club. After his large success with Harlequins, he decided to dive into mastering Havanas. After three short years he had convention and national winners.

Larry encouraged the growth of the breed in the Mid-Atlantic region and helped to found the East Coast Havana Organization serving as its president.

Larry had a strong place in his heart for youth. He would work with them and show them what a good rabbit was supposed to look like. He would sell some of his very best to the youth and would encourage them with their endeavors. As the youth in the area increased in the quality of their stock, he would even get a chuckle when they beat him on the show table with his bloodlines.

Besides the Havanas, Larry also raised beautiful Florida Whites and had recently decided to team up with Bruce Himmelberger in New Zealand. Larry served the rabbit community in many areas including Vice President of the Berks County Rabbit Breeders Association. He was willing to lend a hand where ever help was needed. I could go on saying that he has done for

the rabbit industry, but will close by saying, "Larry, we will miss you greatly."

## President: Dallas Meyer, IL



What a winter this has been! For those of you that did not know, I had surgery on December 17, 2013. I had a thumb joint rebuilt with a tendon from my arm.

The recovery time is six weeks wearing a hard splint that comes up almost to the elbow. This has to be worn all the time, even when showering. The only time it was removed was to change the little sock under it and to ice the arm with strict warnings that the thumb had to stay put and not move. This made putting on coats almost impossible. I did find an old zip-up sweatshirt and an old blue chore coat where I could get my arm into the sleeve. Between Christmas and New Years the snow showed up and has not left yet. The past couple of weeks sub zero temps and extreme wind chills have arrived making doing chores whole lot of fun. As I type this I cannot wait, because in two days the brace

comes off and at least I will be able to wear regular winter clothes and it won't happen none too soon. Starting in a couple of days the real cold is going to get here. The weather man says we will see temps near -25 F with wind chills of -45 F.

These will be new records for this part of the country. Who said raising rabbits was fun?

Now time to talk about the important issues in the rabbit world. The Standard committee has been working on some proposed changes to the Havana Standard. The membership needs to vote on these changes according to the ARBA. Please take time and read each change and decide if you think this change would be good for the breed. I know there has been quite a bit of conversation between the board of directors on why some of these changes are needed. The only thing I will say is we have a very nice utility breed of animal and it is very competitive on the show table. We don't want to change this.

I was lucky enough to spend a lot of time years ago with Oren Reynolds and he told me many times that some breeders always want to change the standard to fit their needs instead of breeding to the standard. I feel there are some good changes proposed and some that will not improve the breed. You need to take a few minutes and read the changes and vote. Remember if you do not vote you have no reason to complain later if you do not like the way some-

thing turns out.

Now that I am getting back to normal (sort of) I will be working with the constitution committee on some upcoming proposed changes to the constitution. We really need to do something about the cost of the newsletter. With printing and mailing costs we are really losing money. The board had hoped that more people would have been willing to receive the newsletter by email because this would have really helped in cutting the cost. Options the board is looking at are charging more for memberships, printing the newsletter four times a year or adding a surcharge if you want the newsletter in printed form. This will be a hard decision to make. If you have any input on this I would like to hear from you. I am sure there will be some discussion about this in Missouri this spring.

I hope to see all of you in Sedalia, Missouri April 5-6, 2014. If you need information you can find it on the Havana Web page. changing the judging order. To say that changing the order to give dilutes a fair shot is confusing to me. I'm not sure how the standards committee will justify changing the Havana judging order and not satins or mini satins or mini rex for example. I have personally won BOS with a blue Havana at convention. I have also won BOG with a blue satin at convention. If the dilute is the best rabbit, it will win under good judging.

We will always need to change and tweak things. We also need to remember that the objective of the Standard of Perfection is to breed to it not to change the SOP to our breeding.

## What are your thoughts Quality Points for the HRBA Club?

As many as you may know, I posted this awhile back on some feedback about adding quality points to the sweeps. There seemed to be some interested.

Tanya looked into the cost of adding these points to our program and found out that it would cost \$120.00 for the addition to the program. I feel that as we grow as a club if we considered adding these points this is a possible formula that we could use:

**BOSV: 1 point**  
**BOV: 2 points**  
**BOSB: 3 points**  
**BOB: 4 points**  
**Reserve in Show: 3**

**points**  
**Best in Show: 4 points**  
**Best 4 Class: 3 points.**

I wouldn't mind seeing some discussion on this. I've been asking myself what I feel that the Pros and Cons on this would be and would like to hear from the membership. I believe that this will "level the playing field", meaning that a small breeder "40 hole rabbitry" vs. a "400 hole rabbitry" would have a chance on being recognized.

Also, I feel that someone who lives in a state that don't have a lot of shows vs. someone who lives in a state that have shows year round. Some breeders just can't compete for our accumula-

tion sweeps, but would be able to compete for our quality sweeps.

I understand that this would be an additional cost to the club for computer program and awards.

Think of this as more someone with no competition vs. someone with competition can rack of the quality points.

So, with these thoughts I leave you with. I look forward to the discussion



**Cons:** Changing the judging order will result in the larger classes at being judged at the end of the breed. The change could slow down judging and cause it to be more difficult to load classes at the end of the breed. In addition, most breeds are judged in alphabetical order. This change would cause Havana's to deviate from this. Blues and Chocolates have consistently been competitive at the best of
