Proposed Constitution and By-Laws changes – Deb Morrison, C&BL's Chairman

Listed are the proposed C&BL's changes, please look them over. Voting ballots will be in the mail soon. You will find 3 proposals with current wording, proposed change and pros and cons about each. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.

Chairman's notes:

-Proposed Change #B-1, Article 3 - Membership – Section 3

This addresses memberships, providing membership cards, Guidebooks, standards and subscription to the Havana Newsletter. Changing wording would update language and address the expense of supplying each member within a household a copy of the guide book.

-Proposed Change #B-2, Article 4 – Elections – Section 2

And

-Proposed Change #B-3, Article 11 – National All Havana Show – Section 1

Both of these proposals address the current dates/dates that materials concerning these sections, specifically ballots will be sent out.

2017 Proposed Constitution and By-Laws Changes

Proposed Change #B-1, Article 3 – Membership – Section 3

Current Wording

Membership in the Association shall be acknowledged by the membership card, issued by the Association, and signed by the Secretary and shall date from the time of such acknowledgement, terminating one year later. Each member shall be provided with a copy of the Havana Guide Book and standard and one year's subscription to the Havana Rabbit Breeders Newsletter.

Proposed Change

Membership in the Association shall be acknowledged by the membership card, issued by the Association, and signed by the Secretary and shall date from the time of such acknowledgement, terminating one year later. Each **family** shall be provided with a copy of the Havana Guide Book (**limit of one (1) Guide Book per household**) and one year's subscription to the Havana Rabbit Breeders Newsletter.

Pros: Adding the statement **family** and (**limit of one (1) Guide Book per household**) adjusts the wording to align with the current procedures concerning Guide Book distribution. Keeping the current wording to give each person in a household who is a member of the HRBA would be an unnecessary and unneeded expense to the HRBA. Also, **and standard** was removed from wording as the HRBA does not send out the standard with the Guide Book.

Cons: none

Proposed Change #B-2, Article 4 – Elections – Section 2

Current Wording

Between August 1 and September 1, the official ballot shall be issued by the Secretary and shall contain the names of all petitioners filing accurately completed forms. Said ballot shall also contain nominees for ARBA Convention Judges.

Proposed Change

Between **August 1 and August 15**, the official ballot shall be issued by the Secretary and shall contain the names of all petitioners filing accurately completed forms. Said ballot shall also contain nominees for ARBA Convention Judges.

Reason: Unifies conflicting dates within the C&BL's concerning when ballots shall be mailed out to membership by Secretary.

Pros: Dates would be unified.

Cons: none

Proposed Change #B-3, Article 11 – National All Havana Show – Section 1

Current Wording

The National All Havana Show shall be selected from presented or mailed to the Secretary by July 1st, stating the sponsoring club, proposed show date and location. If more than one bid is received, bids shall be added to the official ballot issue by the Secretary, between August 1st and September 1st, and shall contain the national All Havana Show bid proposals. The All Havana Show may not be held in the same state two years in a row.

Proposed Change

The National All Havana Show shall be selected from presented or mailed to the Secretary by July 1st, stating the sponsoring club, proposed show date and location. If more than one bid is received, bids shall be added to the official ballot issue by the Secretary, between **August 1st and August 15th**, and shall contain the national All Havana Show bid proposals. The All Havana Show may not be held in the same state two years in a row.

Pros: Dates would be unified.

Cons: none

2015 to present – Member of Executive Board of LaCygne Chamber of Commerce.

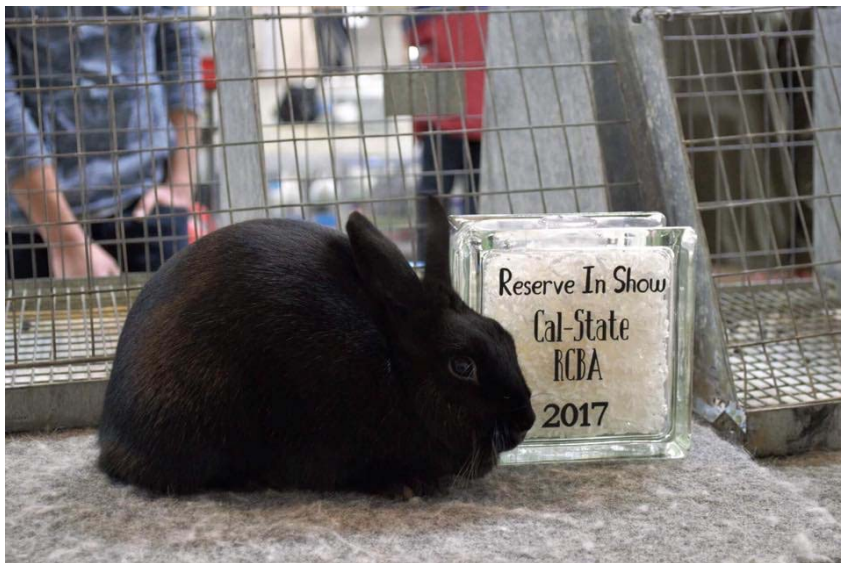
2015 to 2016 - President Midwest Regional Dwarf Hotot Rabbit Club

I have been raising rabbits for show since the age of 9. I show along with my husband, Rob. I began by raising Satins through a youth career. Today our rabbitry currently consists of approximately 500 holes in the breeds of Satins, Mini Satins, Havanas, Florida Whites, New Zealand's, American Sables and Standard Chins. I currently serve on the Havana Rabbit Breeders Board of Directors where I helped create and currently lead the Havana Scholarship Committee. I also serve as a director with the American Sable Rabbit Society and I serve on the ARBA Photo Committee.

I have presented at ARBA's RabbitCon Event four times in the past. I take great pride in educating about the rabbit industry. I most recently traveled to Malaysia to give a presentation on the industry.

I became a licensed ARBA registrar in early 2015.

We have been privileged enough to win one ARBA Best In Show and four Group wins at ARBA Conventions. We have 38 National/Convention BOB/BOS wins with 6 different breeds.

Outside of rabbits, I own and operate a large dog spa. I have two "children" of my own, a Bengal Cat named Kaia and a German Shorthaired Pointer named Benelli. If I ever have free time (which is rare!) I love being outside, fishing, kayaking, gardening and watching baseball.

Auction Committee Report

The Indy Convention is just a few short weeks away. Make plans to attend the "Have a Havana Auction" and purchasing those new bloodlines that you've been thinking about all year long or at least since you got home from the Spring Nationals. The Havana Auction is a great opportunity to purchase Havanas and/or support the National Havana club. Proceeds from the Havana Auction are split 50/50 between the Havana RBA and the seller. Or, if you want to support the Havana Youth Scholarship, this is perfect time to donate your part to that fund. To make that donation, let us know during the Auction and we will make sure that the funds are placed in the Youth Scholarship account.

We will continue the same format as we have in the several year's. There will be a limit on the number of rabbits, the number that each exhibitor may put in each variety and only one buck per variety/per exhibitor. Also, we will continue with the one-way traffic. Please note, as long as you move in the same direction, you are welcome to skip past any rabbit or go ahead of others who are looking/handling rabbits/varieties that you may not be interested in. The Auction will be some time on Wednesday, October 4th. Time will be posted during the convention.

Auction Guidelines:

- Sellers Limit:** 2 rabbits per variety per exhibitor. Not more than 1 buck per variety. No limit on does.
- Auction Limit:** There will be a limit of 24 Havanas. Additionally there will be a limit of 6 rabbits per variety (6 Black, 6 Blue, 6 Chocolate and 6 Broken). Slots will be filled on a first come basis.
- Each rabbit/pedigree must be accompanied by a completed sales slip.
- All rabbits must have a full, 3 generation, pedigree that must be presented to the auction committee before the start of the auction. Accumulated leg/legs, Registration and Grand Champion paperwork, etc. are also nice to have with the pedigree if possible.
- We ask that you not place DQ'd rabbits in the auction. Sick rabbits will be asked to be removed from the Auction viewing area.
- Seller has the right to set a minimum bid on each entry.
- If there is any information that you would like the auctioneer to say about your Havana during the auction, i.e. how it placed in the show/shows, or if they are related to a particular rabbit, etc., please place a note with the pedigree.
- Youth rabbits placed in the Auction need to be marked so that buyers know to pick them up in the Youth Havana area during check-out.
- Deadline to declare an auction rabbit is Tuesday, October. 3rd, 6 p.m.

If you plan to place a rabbit/rabbits in the auction, you can reserve your slot ASAP (shoot me an email or text) any time before Monday, October. 2nd, 6 p.m. During the convention, we have coop tags (and zip ties) available for you to hang on the coop for each rabbit that has been declared for the auction. Also there is a red notebook in the Havana Booth or with me, to place your pedigrees for your declared auction rabbits or to look at the pedigrees of prospective purchases before the auction.
